## PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Shoes that are not fully closed or have spike/pointy heels are not permitted in any production areas. If work will be performed outside of the designated walkways, steel-toed safety shoes with metatarsals must be worn.

Approved safety glasses with side shields (either prescription or non-prescription) that have the ANSI Z87.1 designation are required.



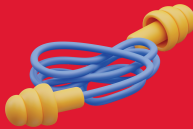
## PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Head protection must be worn at all times in production areas and must meet the requirements of ANSI Z89.1.

Hearing protection must be worn at all times when in production areas.

High visibility safety vests are required to be worn when in production areas.

Fall protection equipment must be used by all contractors when working at elevated locations.

Stay attentive to the continuous operations within our production facilities and remain aware of your surroundings at all times!

## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Observe and comply with all safety warning signs.
- Do not touch forgings, equipment, or metal shavings.
- Stay within the marked walkways and watch for uneven or slippery surfaces.
- Do not pass under overhead rolling doors—use personnel doors only.
- Watch for overhead cranes and mobile equipment, including forklifts. Do not walk under suspended loads. Mobile equipment has the right of way and always stay at least 6' from mobile equipment that is operating.
- In the event of an emergency, your ECG host will direct you to the nearest safe exit or gathering point.
- All visitors must be escorted while in our facilities unless alternative arrangements have been made.
